It's hard to imagine all that's happened since Judy accepted the call to preach at a small church in Uganda. How nine people were willing to give of their time and money to travel 8000 miles to speak, sing and pray at a Pastor's conference in a slum district of Kampala. Where we gave away desperately needed bibles and bicycles to Pastors from remote areas. And now our team is preparing to leave on September 21st and return to Uganda for two pastor conferences and a medical mission at two orphanages. And Yes! This will be our 5th year trip to Uganda. Who would have guessed?

From a trip to the countryside of Kampala to 5 unspoiled acres donated to Pastor David and with the blessing of many supporters we now have two dormitories, one toilet building for boys and one for girls, a 7 classroom building, a kitchen building, an onsite bowl water pump and 158 children ages 3-14. And with monies from a private foundation, bunk-beds, mattresses and mosquito nets were provided for children, many of which had never slept on a bed.

This year we will bring medical services and readers for the two orphanages and their neighboring communities. In addition we plan to teach Pastors how to fit readers so they can take them back to their villages since many people are unable to work due to poor eye sight. Also we plan to show them how to build a sand water filter system to be used in their villages since water purity is a huge problem.

As you can imagine there are continuing needs at the orphanage to furnish the classrooms, kitchen and personal items for the children. We consider it a privilege to be able to make these trips to Uganda and to sow into the lives of so many pastors and orphan children. We realize we cannot do it alone and so we greatly appreciate your continuing support and prayers.
